Dear Kingsway Families and Staff,

We hope everyone had a safe and relaxing Thanksgiving break!

Yesterday the State of New Jersey and the Camden County Department of Health released the updated COVID-19 Activity Level Index (CALI), indicating that our region continues to experience “high” virus activity. Based on this information, Kingsway will maintain the schedule previously released and return to our hybrid, in-person Phase 1 schedule next week, December 7, 2020. Should other factors change this decision, we will let you know as quickly as possible. We urge you all to be prepared for a variety of contingencies and possibilities during this time.

As mentioned previously, our quarantine and exclusion procedures while we are in the “high” rating will be more stringent, as we are required to quarantine close contacts of positive COVID-19 cases, as well as close contacts of those with COVID-19 symptoms. In addition, based on updated guidance from the Department of Health, if someone in your household is being tested for COVID-19 due to illness, students/staff should remain home until the test result is received. In addition, while the CDC has recently allowed quarantine periods as short as seven days under certain circumstances, we will continue to follow NJ DOE and NJ DOH guidance for schools, which requires a 14 day quarantine period. This may lead to additional program disruptions, and we ask that you bear with us as we follow the guidance we have been given to support the health and safety of the Kingsway community.
